Areas Patrolled





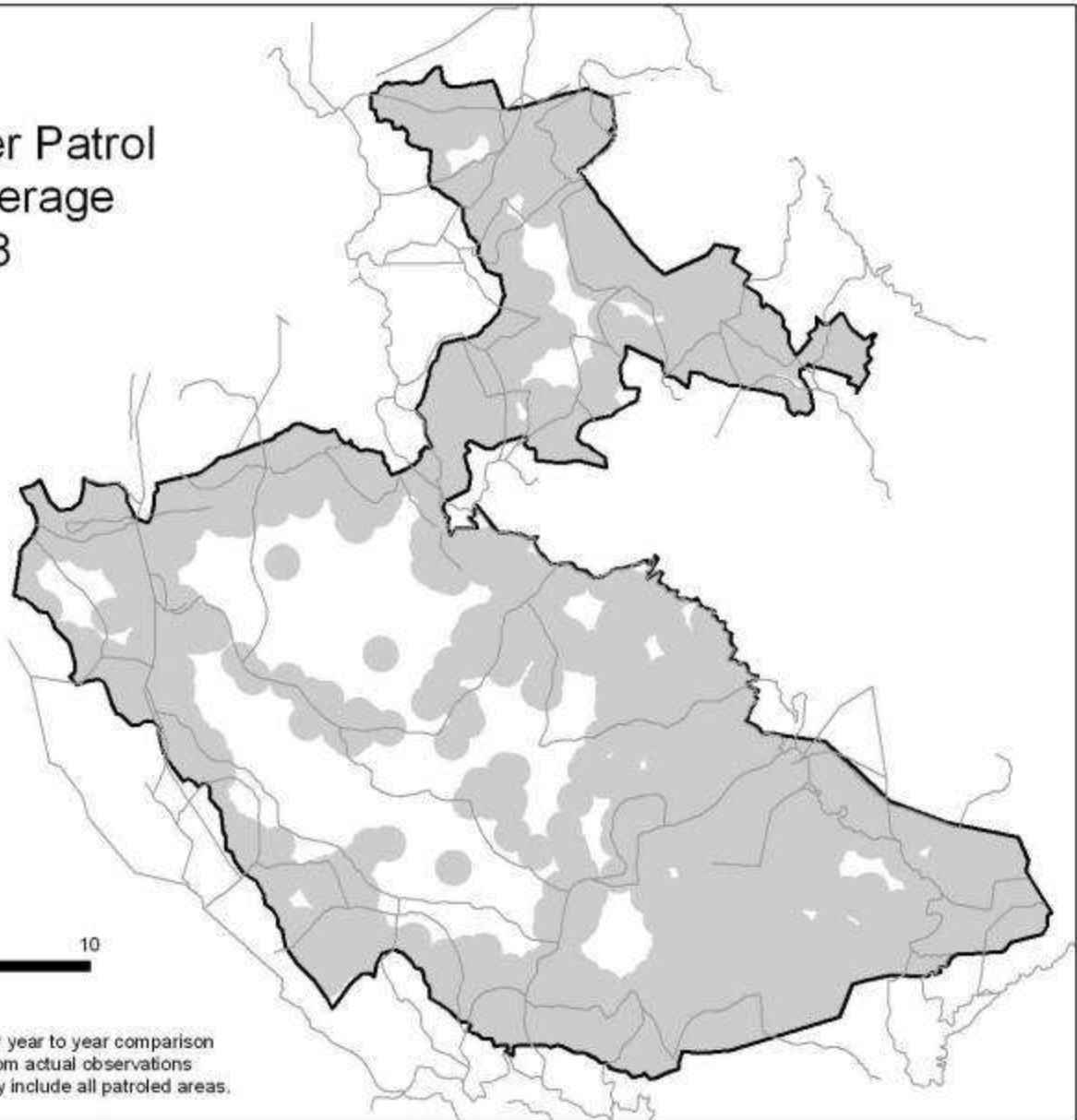
BINP Ranger Patrol Total Coverage 2008



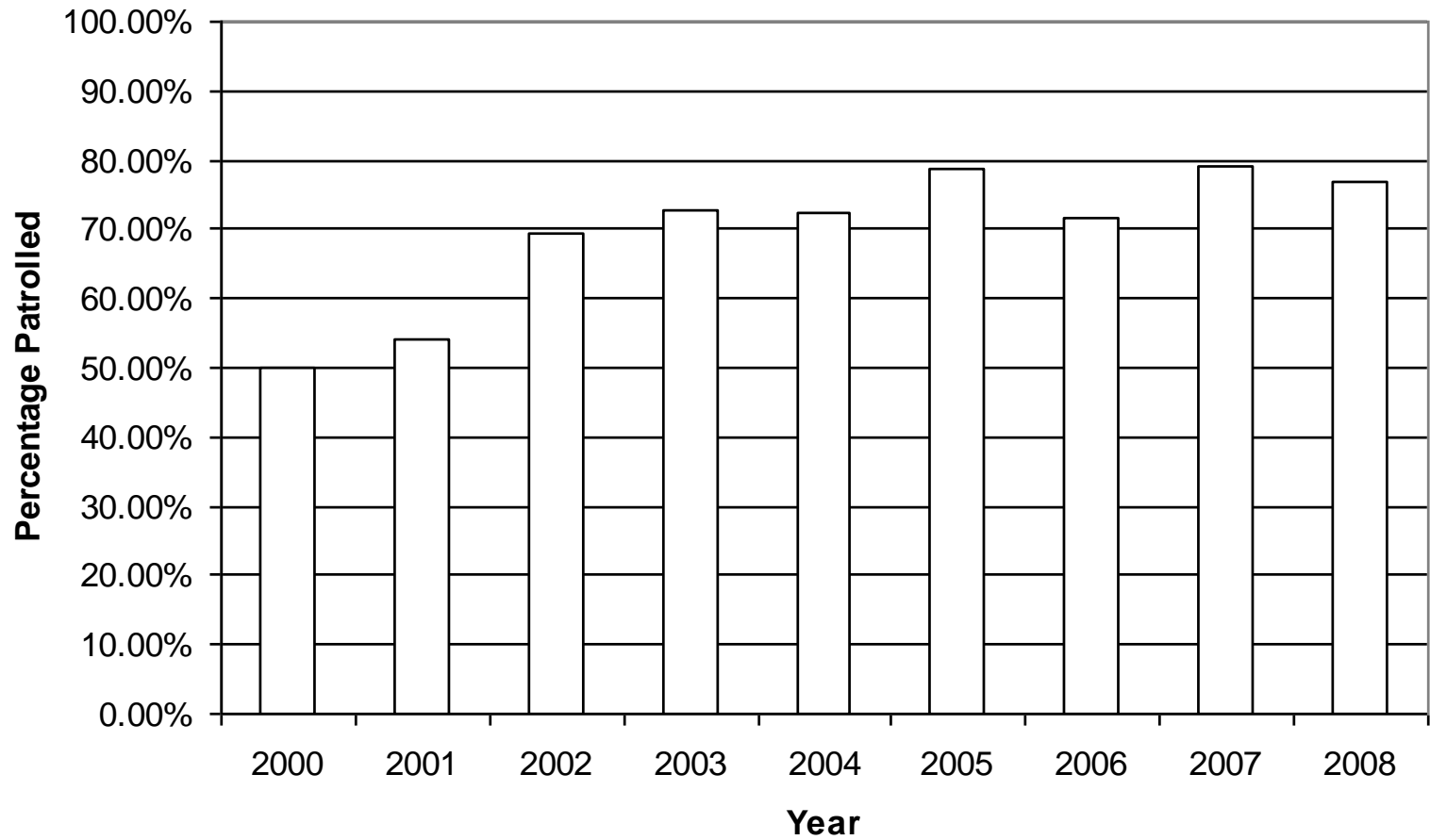

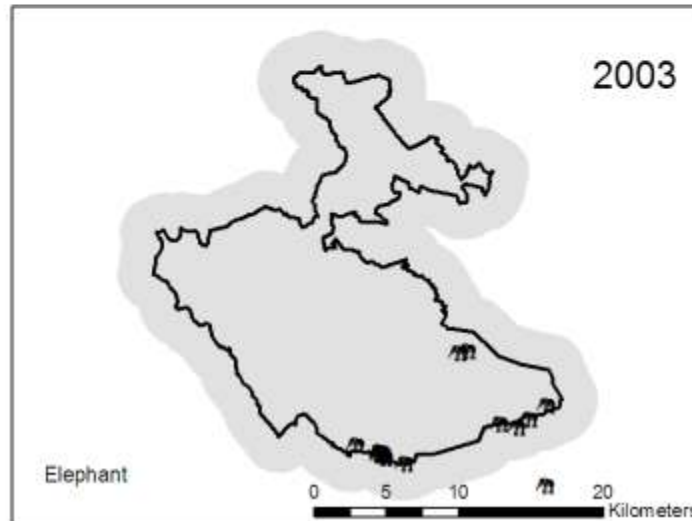
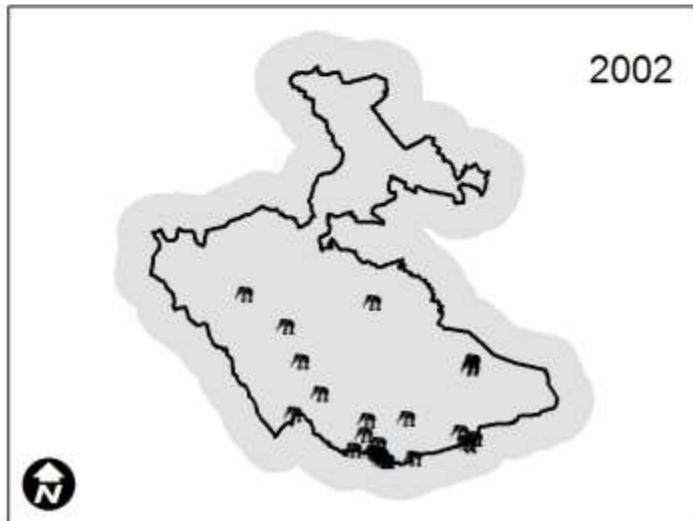
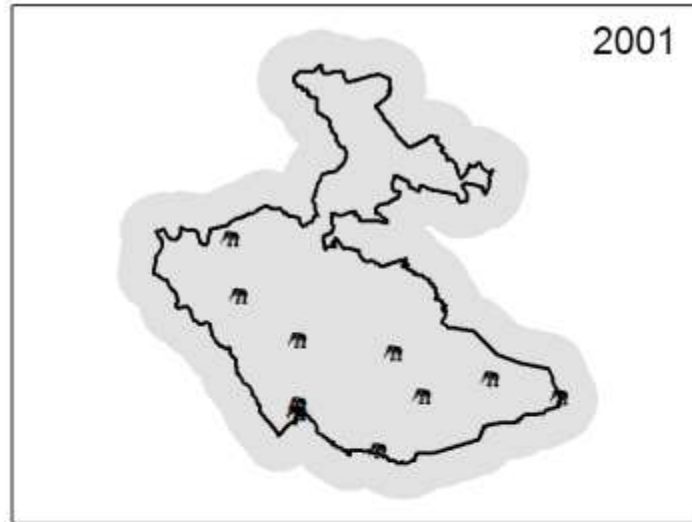
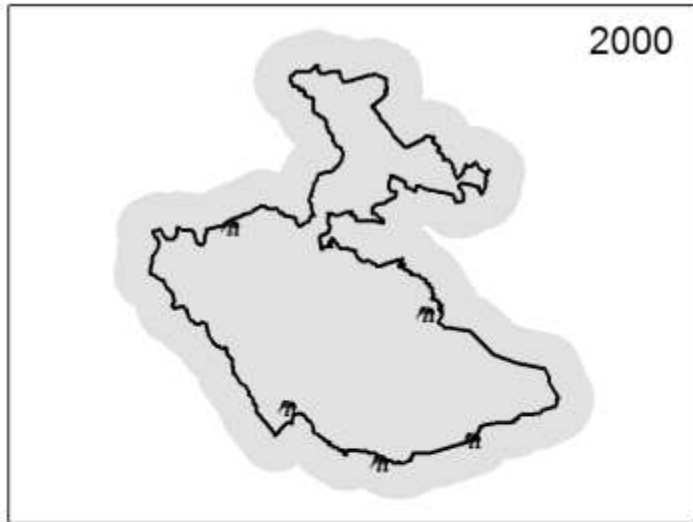
Percentage of BINP Patrolled by Year
